

After two successful years touring Europe, Ezralow Dance is now touring North America with OPEN. Following its January 9, 2016 performance in Temecula, California, OPEN will have its East Coast Premiere on February 3, 2016 at the Prince Theater in Philadelphia, and then make its way west with performances on April 29 and 30, 2016, at the Wallis Annenberg Center for the Performing Arts for a "hometown debut" in Beverly Hills. creative fantasy and dramatic emotion.


